

POSTER PRESENTATION FOR LA-CCI

Carefully prepare and print your poster well in advance of the conference. There will be no time or materials available for last-minute preparations for the meeting.

It is impossible to read large amounts of text in a poster presentation; therefore the most important thing is to keep the preparation simple, clear and concise.

The poster should focus on the key points of your work. A poster must be designed to:

- Attention.
- Provide a brief description of their work.
- Encourage discussion and questions.

The dimensions of the poster should be 90 cm wide and 120 cm high.

The title of the poster should appear at the top in capital letters approximately 25 mm. The name / s of author / s and affiliation / s should be placed below the title, along with the address / email is for possible contacts. The smallest text on the poster should be at least 9mm high, and the most important points must be in a larger font.

Use colors to highlight and make your poster more attractive as well as images, diagrams, charts, figures, etc., rather than only text wherever possible. Also be careful to not overuse these resources.

Make your poster as self-guided and self-explaining as possible. This will allow attendees to see the poster while he / authors are not present can get a general idea of the work and eventually formulated specific questions which can then be done in the time allotted for that purpose.

Already in the meeting:

- The need to hang the poster material will be available at the venue.
- The posters of each session will be available to view for a day of the meeting.
- The day appointed for the presentation, the poster will be hung during the half hour before the start of the formal activities of the meeting (8:30 to 9:00 am) and removed during twenty minutes after the completion of activities (19:10 to 19:30 h. pm).

At least one author must be present by the poster during the session to answer the concerns of the attendees (10:20-11:00h am and 16:30-17:10h pm). The jury for selecting the best poster of each session will also use this time to ask the questions it deems necessary to complete the evaluation of the papers presented.
